Access Statement for Little Galey Cottage

Introduction

Thornthwaite Farm is a working farm nestled in the southern Lake District fells and is ideal for those who want an enjoyable and relaxing self-catering holiday. We have five self catering holiday cottages and a log cabin surrounded by 500 acres of fields, ancient woodland and streams. Little Galey Cottage is a semi-detached Lakeland cottage, it has a downstairs lounge and separate kitchen/dining room and a downstairs bathroom. Upstairs via an open staircase there is one double bedroom and one twin bedroom. The cottage is fully furnished.

Pre-Arrival

- For full details and maps of how to reach us please see the Contact section of our website. Alternatively, you can plan your journey by car using a journey planning website; simply enter your postcode and ours, which is LA20 6DF to get directions.
- Directions will be emailed two days prior to your arrival.
- The nearest railway station is Foxfield which is 4 miles away from Thornthwaite Farm.
- No bus service is available, but taxis can be booked from <http://taxigaz.co.uk/> or over the phone on 01229 716444.

Key Collection, Welcome and Car Parking

- Parking is available on site for one car, the maximum distance to the cottage is 20m.
- Parking areas are loose stone.
- Keys are collected from the Farmhouse, around 25m from the parking. Keys can be brought to your car if desired.
- A familiarisation tour of your cottage is provided on arrival.
- There is an outside light above each cottage entrance, which can be operated from inside.

Entrance to Property

- There are three steps up followed by three steps down to the front door.
- The main door is 750mm wide over a 30mm lip. The floor covering inside the entrance is short pile carpet.
- The main door leads straight into the lounge.
- The entrance is well lit both outside and inside, and outside lights are switched on prior to arrival at night.

Halls, Stairs, Landings, Passageways

- The cottage is on two floors with a lounge, kitchen/dining area and bathroom downstairs and bedrooms upstairs.
- The stairway is wooden open treads.
- The stairways and landings are lit using ceiling pendants.

Sitting Room/Lounge

- The lounge is all on one level.
- There are two 2 person settees which have limited movement
- There is a 40" widescreen digital television with remote control, subtitle, and a DVD player.
- A log burning fire is situated on a 20mm high slate hearth.

- Lighting is a mixture of table lamps and ceiling pendants.
- The floor covering is short pile carpet with a large rug in the centre.

Dining Room

- The dining area is situated within the kitchen.
- There isn't space around the table for a wheelchair.
- Chairs are upright without arms. All chairs are moveable.
- The area is lit via ceiling pendant.
- The floor covering is vinyl.

Kitchen

- The kitchen is adjacent to the main living area, with step free, level access.
- The worktop/sink/hob are 900mm above the floor. The microwave is situated on top of the worktops.
- The door of the oven drops down, with the handle being 710mm above the floor.
- The highest shelf in the fridge/freezer is 650mm above the floor.
- Wall cupboards are 1800mm from the floor.
- There are two separate hot and cold Sink taps.
- The kettle is cordless, and able to rotate 360 degrees.
- The kitchen is lit with ceiling pendant.
- The floor is laminate vinyl.

Bedrooms and Sleeping Areas

- There are two bedrooms, both of which are on the first floor. There is a double bedroom and a twin room.

- The clear door opening width in the twin and double rooms is 650mm.
- Most furniture has limited movement.
- In the double room and the twin room there is limited space around the bed.
- Each bedroom is lit by a combination of bedside lamps and ceiling lamps.
- The height of the mattress in each room is 550mm, and there is 260mm of clear space underneath.
- Each room has a wardrobe and bedside tables. The height of the wardrobe rails are 1800mm, and cannot be adjusted.
- Colour contrast between the floor, walls and doorways is medium.
- All bedding is non-feather.
- The floor covering is short pile carpet.

Laundry/Utility Room

- The bathroom is downstairs adjacent to the lounge, the bathroom is on step free level access.
- The door opening is 650mm wide.
- There is a step in shower.
- The WC seat is 430mm above the ground.
- The height of the washbasin is 850mm, and there is a narrow pedestal underneath the sink.
- The sink has two individually controlled taps.
- The room is lit by ceiling downlighters.
- The colour contrast of floor, walls and towels is low.
- The floor is tiled.

Garden

- The cottages are set in 500 acres of land. Most land is undulating, there are no hardcore paths in place.
- Little Galey cottage has its own enclosed garden with garden bench and lawned area. A Metal table and chairs are also provided during the summer.

Additional Information

- Dogs are allowed in the cottage.
- Overall the colour contrast in the cottage is good, aside from the bathroom.
- The nearest hospital is situated in Barrow-in-Furness. Postcode LA14 4LF.
- The nearest doctors surgery is situated in Broughton-in-Furness, approximately 4miles away. Telephone 01229 716337. Postcode LA20 6EZ.
- Internet access is available free of charge through a wifi network which works in all cottages.
- Mobile phone networks have limited reception and do not work indoors.
